With the war in Ukraine uppermost in our minds at the moment, I would like to share with you this message from Bishop Martin.

"We are living in times that were inconceivable even a short time ago, and I am aware of the rising anxiety across our nation, reflected in communities across Suffolk. As we pray fervently for peace, each of us, as public Christians, is bearing the fears and anxieties of our communities, as we seek to be agents of hope in a time of profound uncertainty and bewilderment. We pray for the people of Ukraine, for the people of Russia, for the victims of this horrendous action, for those fighting, for those working hard for peace. Bishop Mike and I are calling on all parishes and congregations of this Diocese this Lent to raise funds through collections, individual gifts, events and activities, to respond to the terrible situation the people of Ukraine are facing – both in the country and as refugees."

It is difficult to watch on TV and hear about the plight of the people of Ukraine, but it is important to remember that each of these people are not just refugees, but they are grandparents, parents, wives, husbands, children and grandchildren and share with us the same hopes and aspirations that we all do, and at the moment their lives are torn apart.

The season of Easter is upon us, this season should appeal particularly to those who have been going through a difficult time recently for one reason or another. The church's seasons mirror our experiences. We move from the awareness of our own mortality on Ash Wednesday, through the darkness of Good Friday to the triumph of Easter Day, stopping off for the light relief of Mothering Sunday, and the important but short-lived celebration of Palm Sunday. Christians are sometimes described as "Easter people." God's raising of Jesus from the dead tells us in whose hands we are held, even in death.






