

From The Rectory ...

On 6th June, I was delighted to be present at the Archdeacon's Visitation Service, which took place at St. Michael's Church, Framlingham, a service where the Churchwardens make a formal declaration to their role, with prayer and encouragement being offered by the Archdeacon. I was delighted that 9 of the benefice Churchwardens were able to attend the service, some of whom can be seen in the photo below, along with the Archdeacon.

But, what is a Churchwarden and what is their role, was a question that I was asked after the service by a couple of people who knew of the service taking place, but not of the role that the Churchwarden has in church. I could write several pages of copy about their role, but to simplify the answer to the question, I like to think that the Churchwardens serve alongside the Rector, ensuring that all matters of church life are in order, including the fabric, finances, services, and people, to name a few areas of



their role. However, I turn to the book, 'Your Church and the Law', for my favoured description...Churchwardens should 'use their best endeavours to encourage the parishioners in the practice of their faith and to promote unity and peace among them. They are to maintain order and decency in the church and churchyard, especially during the time of divine service', for me a perfect description of such an important role in the life of our churches here in Mid-Loes.

I want to take this opportunity to thank the Churchwardens for their role in supporting the churches, but also in their support of myself as Rector of the benefice, and for a lot of the 'unseen' work that is carried out behind the scenes.

Whilst thanking the Churchwardens for their role, I will use this opportunity to thank everyone who plays their part in keeping our churches open, and the church grounds in good order. I am hoping not to miss anyone out, but thank you to those who clean our churches; the flower teams; those who maintain the church grounds; the Sides People who welcome people to our churches with a smile; those who read during church services; those who prepare and serve refreshments at our services; the benefice choir; the organists who commit so much time to playing at the various services held across the benefice; the Treasurers, who oversee church finances; those who are members of the PCC, who act as Trustees of our churches; those who are members of 'The Friends of...' who provide support of our churches through fundraising and overseeing important projects that take place within our churches.

As you can see, there are numerous roles within our churches, and I apologise if I have missed one, but each role is vital in keeping our churches open, and to all who attend our many services. It is fair to say, that not everyone involved in the many roles detailed previously, would call themselves 'church-goers' but they undertake a role because of their love of their local church, and playing a part in the community in which they live, each person bring a gift or talent unique to them, but shared with many. Is there anything listed within the roles that you would like to get involved with? Do you have a gift or talent that could be shared with your local church? The involvement can be as little or as much as you wish, and I know that whatever it is that you are able to offer, it will be gratefully received.

All the roles shown, and each person involved, plays such an important part in keeping our churches open and alive, but there is always room for more people to be involved.

Have a think, and if there is a role in which you feel called to be involved, please let me know, you will be warmly welcomed.







For over 30 years, Families in Need (FIND) Ipswich, has offered a lifeline to people in Ipswich and the surrounding areas who are experiencing poverty and despair.

FIND provides free food parcels and personal care items to help people get through a crisis, as well as furniture, bedding and other household items where the person or family has none.

An army of over 80 volunteers regularly give their time freely to check and sort the donated food, collect items from local stores, make up the food parcels and deliver them.

It's a six-day a week operation.

The demand for food parcels has risen year on year and FIND now distributes an average of 120-150 parcels every week and even more at Christmas - more than 7,000 every year.

Going Forward

Each church within the benefice has now become a donation point where there are boxes in the church porches in which donations can be left. The donations will then be collected on a regular basis and taken to the offices of FIND. Currently, the food requirements are as follows:

Long grain rice - Long-life whole milk
Toiletries for men, women and children
Tinned vegetables, meat, fruit/desserts
Coffee - Sugar - Jam - Soup
Pet food (dog, cat, fish, rabbit/guinea pig)


