# From The Rectory...

am delighted that this year extra church services have been added to what is already a busy schedule of worship and celebration across the 8 churches within our benefice. Each of the additional services not only acknowledge some of the depth and richness of the church calendar, but also celebrate life events and the life around us that are important to many people.

For example, during Holy Week, the week leading up to Easter Sunday, services will be held acknowledging and reflecting the last days of Jesus' journey to the cross; a service is planned to celebrate marriage and an opportunity for marriages to be blessed and stories shared; we will be holding a Rogation Service, an opportunity to celebrate the people who work on the land that surrounds us, and giving thanks for the agriculture industry that surrounds us here in Mid-Loes. But, we start with Ash Wednesday (5th March), where we begin our journey through Lent.

An Ash Wednesday Service will be held at The Priory Church of St. Mary, Letheringham, at 11.30am, a service which signals the start of Lent, a 40 day period (not including Sundays) when we have the opportunity to reflect on our lives, an opportunity to repent (saying sorry for things we shouldn't have done or said); reflecting on our life through acts of fasting, of praying, a time to bring ourselves nearer to God. It is not to be a period of shame or guilt, it must be a period of time to become a better version of ourselves.

Quite often to achieve this, people will give up, or abstain from something for 40 days, with the best known being chocolate and alcohol, which are good things (I think?), but the importance behind abstaining from these things is to find time to bring ourselves closer to God, acknowledging our faults and simply saying sorry. The 40 days reflects Christ's time in the wilderness prior to the

beginning of his ministry here on earth, so this period of abstinence reflects the fasting that he experienced, allowing and preparing himself for his ministry.

However, perhaps a little different, but how about using Lent as a period of time to give to others, giving in both a practical and spiritual sense. For 40 days we could pick the phone up each day making contact with someone who might be grateful for a chat; each day being able to help a neighbour with a simple chore; we could pray each day for friends and family, and for those we don't know, those people who face all sorts of challenges and dangers in their everyday life; each day we could walk for a period of time that suits you, giving thanks for the beauty of the environment in which we live... all positive things that could be considered for Lent this year.

Whatever it is that we choose to do for Lent, Ash Wednesday is an important day that signals the beginning of our personal journey through to Easter, and this year's Ash Wednesday is a service to which ALL are welcome. It is a time of reflection, a time to repent (turn back to God); and importantly it is a time for us to listen to God, and it is an opportunity to become a better version of ourselves.



#### **HOO NOTES**

#### **CHURCH CRAWLERS**

Hoo Church was delighted to welcome a group of people from Aldeburgh, who styled themselves as Church Crawlers, which is a term thought to have been coined by John Betjeman during a radio broadcast in 1948, and refers to an interest in old churches and their architecture, art and craftsmanship.

The leader of the group, Jamie Norman, organised a visit to our church on 19 December & had invited Rev Roy Tricker to point out things of special interest. The audience of about 45 people was enthusiastic & very generous in their appreciation.


